

DECISION No GB/2025/5

of the European Cybersecurity Industrial, Technology and Research Competence Centre Governing Board on amending Annex 1 of DECISION No GB/2022/7

THE GOVERNING BOARD,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2021/887 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 May 2021 establishing the European Cybersecurity Industrial, Technology and Research Competence Centre and the Network of National Coordination Centres ('ECCC')¹, in particular Article 13 (3) (i),

Having regard to the rules of procedure of the ECCC and in particular Article 9-11 thereof.

WHEREAS:

- (1) According to paragraph 2 of Article 8 of the founding Regulation, the Community shall consist of industry, including SMEs, academic and research organizations, other relevant civil society associations as well as, as appropriate, relevant European Standardization Organizations, public entities, and other entities dealing with cybersecurity operational and technical matters. Where relevant, stakeholders in sectors that have an interest in cybersecurity and that face cybersecurity challenges shall also be included. The Community shall bring together the main stakeholders with regard to cybersecurity technological, industrial, academic, and research capacities in the Union. It shall involve national coordination centres, European Digital Innovation Hubs, where relevant, as well as Union institutions, bodies, offices, and agencies with relevant expertise, such as ENISA.
- (2) Pursuant to point (i) of paragraph 3 of Article 13 of the founding Regulation, the Governing Board shall take necessary strategic decisions, in particular with regard to the adoption of guidelines for assessing and registering entities as members of the Community.
- (3) Considering that a first Guideline for Community Registration was approved by the ECCC Governing Board in 2022 (**DECISION No GB/2022/7**)
- (4) Taking into account the work performed by the former working group of the ECCC (WG1) and the consultation with the DPO and JRC on the possible changes to the registration form, an amendment to Annex 1 of **DECISION No GB/2022/7** is required to reflect these updates.

(5) The amendment to Annex 1 shall be implemented without modifying or removing the remaining provisions of **DECISION No GB/2022/7**, which shall remain in force.

Article 1

Annex 1, as attached hereto, is hereby adopted and shall replace Annex 1 of **DECISION No GB/2022/7** in its entirety.

DECISION No GB/2022/7 shall remain in full force, save for the replacement of Annex 1 as indicated above.

Article 2

This Decision shall take effect on the day following its adoption, repealing Annex 1 of DECISION No GB/2022/7 and incorporating in its place Annex 1 of the current decision.
