Governing Board
on the application by analogy of the Implementing Rules of the Staff Regulations
adopted by the Commission

THE GOVERNING BOARD of the European Cybersecurity Industrial, Technology and Research Competence Centre ('Competence Centre'),

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials ('Staff Regulations') and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants ('CEOS') of the European Union, laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/68, ¹ and in particular Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2021/887 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 May 2021 establishing the European Cybersecurity Industrial, Technology and Research Competence Centre and the Network of National Coordination Centres ('founding Regulation'),²

Having regard to Communication C(2014) 6543 final of 26 September 2014 from Vice-President Šefčovič to the Commission on the guidelines on the implementation of Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations with regard to the implementing rules applicable in the agencies,

WHEREAS:

- (1) It is necessary to adopt implementing rules for giving effect to the Staff Regulations;
- (2) In application of Article 110 (2) of the Staff Regulations, the decisions referred to in the Annex of this decision shall apply by analogy to the Centre either nine months after the date of its adoption or by decision of the Governing Board, at an earlier date;

HAS ADOPTED THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Article 1

The general implementing rules of the Staff Regulations, as adopted by the Commission, and listed in the Annex shall apply by analogy to the staff of the Competence Centre.
