02 Develop, connect and support the collaboration between the European cybersecurity communities building on existing efforts, notably (but not only) from ECSO and the four "pilot projects" as well as the Cybersecurity Atlas.

O3 Promote innovation through matchmaking and industrial partnering events, funding opportunities through InfoDays and knowledge sharing through cross-border national and regional events.




