ECCC towards financial autonomy

- ECCC financial autonomy is progressing well and foreseen by Q3/2024; important milestones ongoing (Host Agreement, SLAs etc.).
- Permanent premises will be delivered in Q3/2024.
- As of June 2024, ECCC has 31 staff members out of 38 foreseen in the regulation; other recruitments are ongoing (HOUs) and new ones soon to be launched (TAs/SNEs).





DEP call CYBER-06: lessons learnt

- Budget allocation: ECCC will be able to spend the full budget allocated to the call.
- Overall, the quality of DEP proposals is increasing.
- The **competition is increasing** while the overall call success rate is decreasing, from 54% (call DEPLOY-CYBER-03) to 46% (call DEPLOY-CYBER-04) and to 35% (call DEPLOY-CYBER-06).
- Open topics are more attractive than targeted oriented ones.
- Potential proposers and applicants are invited to rely on their NCC for guidance in project proposal development and project implementation.

Future DEP Work Programme

- Currently being discussed by ECCC Governing Board
- Total budget for Work Programme: EUR 353 million, distributed across the 3 years 2025-2027
- Focus on the Implementation of the Cyber Solidarity Act including relevant technologies for cyber hubs and on the support other activities, including the implementation of European Legislation on Cybersecurity



Community building

- NCCs network has a strategic role in building the Cyber Community, this is why all European
 cybersecurity stakeholders from technological, industrial, academic and research sectors –
 are invited to cooperate with their NCC at national level
- We also encourage the NCCs to continue to carry out the work of both promoting the Community as
 well as assessing the relevant entities established in their MS, so as to allow the ECCC to register them
 as Community members, and make the Community larger and stronger.
- Community members play an active role in the activities of the ECCC, e.g. provide strategic advice on the Strategic Agenda, positively contributing to definition of priorities for the funding programmes.
- Building the Community is crucial for successfully achieving the ECCC strategic objectives.
