ECCC – Cyber Community

The Network

- One national coordination centre (NCC) from each Member State.
- National capacity building and link with existing initiatives
- NCCs engage and coordinate with the industry, the public sector and the research community.



The Cyber Community

The strategic Advisory Group

- Twenty members to be appointed by the Governing Board.
- Organises public consultations to collect input for the ECCC agenda and work programme

The Cybersecurity Competence Community

A large, open, and diverse group of cybersecurity stakeholders from research and the private and public sectors that have an interest in cybersecurity and that face cybersecurity challenges

The Cybersecurity Competence Community

A large, open, and diverse group of cybersecurity stakeholders from research and the private and public sectors, including both civilian and defence sectors.

- ✓ The Centre, Network and Community should help to advance and disseminate the latest cybersecurity products and services
- Provides input to the activities of the competence centre to the multiannual work programme and to the annual work programme





Splits up into working groups for regular dialogue

Supports stakeholders at their request, public-private coordination



ATLAS: platform for the Community

- Shall be registered as members of the Community
 - · Only entities established within the MSs
- NCCs will
 - provide the registration form on its website
 - carry out an assessment based on membership criteria described in registration guidelines
- Accepted applications, sent by the NCCs to ATLAS
 - the portal https://cybersecurity-atlas.ec.europa.eu
- Registration process planned to start during September 2025





ATLAS - What's in for me?

- Be part of a trusted/vetted cybersecurity community and possibility to apply for membership in the Strategic Advisory Group and other working groups
- Have access to a platform that would allow to discover new opportunities to connect and to identify research/business partners to participate in cross-border cooperation
- Be able to provide feedback on strategy and policies from the industry perspective

Strategic Advisory Group

- Call for expression of interest planned for September 2025
- Shall provide the ED and the GB with strategic advice
 - on the Agenda, the annual work programme and the multiannual work programme
- Ensure a comprehensive, ongoing dialogue between Community and ECCC
- Consists of 20 members
 - expertise on cybersecurity research, industrial development, offering, implementing, or deploying professional services or products
 - Representatives of the Commission and of other Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies, may be invited by the Strategic Advisory Group to participate in and support its work
- Meetings at least three times/year



ATLAS: Community Registration Guidelines

- First version was published on ECCC website in 2022
 - ECCC GB Decision No 2022 7 on Community membership guidelines WG1
- An updated version will be published in September/October 2025:
 - Membership criteria/requirements
 - The application process (e.g. assessment of applications and related outcome: positive or negative)
 - Registration process in ATLAS upon positive acceptance
 - Changes in the membership status: revoking of registration, withdrawal, changes of registration data
